What is UPP?

South Lake Pediatrics recognizes that children without health insurance are not getting the medical care they need. South Lake Pediatrics responded to this issue by developing the Uninsured Patient Program in January 2008. The UPP program is designed to assist families in the process of applying for Medical Assistance and Minnesota Care.

Who can participate?

UPP is available to anyone dealing with a challenging financial situation who would like help navigating through the Medical Assistance or Minnesota Care application process.



How does the program work?

It begins with a call to one of our certified MN Community Application Agents:

- ◆ We will discuss your situation and send you a list of the documentation you will need.
- ◆ We will meet with you at the South Lake Pediatrics location that is most convenient for you and complete the application together.
- ◆ We will submit the application for you and follow-up as needed to make sure your county office has everything they need.
- ◆ This process usually takes 30-45 days.

Can my child receive care during the application process?

Yes. However, if your application is denied for any reason, you will be responsible for any charges incurred.



What if my application is denied?

If your application is denied by both Medical Assistance and Minnesota Care for excess income, South Lake Pediatrics has a discount program available. This discount program is only available after you have been denied by both Medical Assistance and Minnesota Care.
